Call for Head Coach - 2021 Canada Summer Games

Overview: The role of the Head Coach is to provide leadership and logistical support to athletes and coaches for 2021 Canada Summer Games. The Head Coach reports to the SNM Technical Director.

Swim Natation Manitoba invites applications for the Head Coach Position for the 2021 Canada Summer Games Manitoba Swim Team.

This position will work in assistance with the Canada Games coaching staff, Mission Staff and SNM Technical Director.

This is a volunteer position that will require some weekend and evening work and includes travel time over the entire 19 months leading up to the Games, January 2020 to August 14, 2021. The Head Coach will be entitled to certain compensation for each activity in accordance with Swim Natation Manitoba's policies.

The successful applicant must be willing to provide a current Child Abuse Registry check and Criminal Record check with vulnerable sector check.

Job Description

The role of the Head Coach is to provide leadership and expertise in the preparation of the athletes and coaches attending the 2021 Canada Summer Games

Major Duties

- Plans, conducts and evaluates Canada Games activities
- Follow and administer the published SNM CSG selection process
- Assigns administrative duties and coaching duties as needed
- Work with the Team Manager to coordinate activities before and during the games, coordinating equipment outfitting and media relations
- Conduct staff meetings before and during the Games
- Report on all Canada Games activities
- Follow Canada Games Code of Conduct as it applies to the Head Coach and Team



Minor Duties

- Identify and track the developing Athletes
- Assist in designing programs when requested
- Act as a mentor to potential assistant coaches
- Liaise with standing committees and attend required meetings

Relationships:

- The Head Coach will work with the Technical Director of Swim Manitoba. The Head Coach will work as a member of a team of coaches, whose goal is to develop a strong group of athletes for the Games.

Education:

- Current Senior Coach (Level 3) NCCP coaching certification – includes MED requirement
- Experience of coaching National Qualifiers and attending Senior Nationals and Age Group Nationals
- Willingness to work in a solution focused manner to improve the quality of the athletes
- Possess a strong knowledge of the technical and tactical aspects of swimming
- Possess excellent communication and team building skills

Deadline to submit the application is January 31, 2020 @ 4:00 PM. Be advised that SNM will follow the Team Manitoba Code of Conduct as it pertains to the week of CSG Swimming.
