



SNM Post-Secondary Returning Student Swimmer Scholarship for 2021 – 2022 Academic Year

1. Description

Two (2) scholarships, in the amount of \$1,500 each, will be awarded to the highest qualifying swimmers enrolled as a full-time student in their second or subsequent years at a Manitoba College or University. This is a one year scholarship. A swimmer may be selected to receive this scholarship up to four times.

2. Eligibility for 2021 – 2022 Academic Year the swimmer must:

- a) Be a resident of Manitoba and member of a SNM registered swim team
- b) Meet the current ManSask time standard in at least one event
- c) Selection of the two athletes will be done with the Canadian senior ranking of their best event. In the event of a tie, we will take their second-best event and so on until the tie is broken.
- d) Have completed the previous school year with a minimum GPA of 2.5
- e) Meet the requirements to be classified as a full time student
- f) Compete at the highest level of competition for which they have qualified (e.g. USPORT Championships, Canadian Championship, Western Championships, ManSask Champ)
- g) Preference will be given to swimmers who compete in both short and long course at the highest level for which they have qualified.
- h) Preference will be given to swimmers that have current USPORT times in Olympic events
- i) Maintain a full-time training and competition schedule as available and outlined by their club



Swim Natation Manitoba Scholarship Selection Process

The SNM Scholarship Selection Committee consists of the SNM Executive Director and the SNM Scholarship Committee. The committee identifies and verifies all swimmers who have applied and have fulfilled the SNM scholarship eligibility requirements. The committee uses the following process to select two swimmers for the scholarship:

Post-Secondary Returning Student Swimmer Scholarship 2021 – 2022 Academic Year

1. Post-Secondary Returning Scholarship - swimmers application must include the following:
 - a) Application information form
 - b) Copy of Manitoba College or University first term transcript
 - c) Confirmation of schedule to a Manitoba College or University for second term
 - d) Club notarized SCM & LCM results from current season, SCM & LCM results from previous season (i.e. Hy-Tek report)
 - e) Completed application received on or before **June 15, 2021 4:00 pm CST**
2. Eligible swimmers who train and compete in both short course and long course seasons will be considered first
3. All eligible swimmers will be ranked from highest to lowest based on Canadian ranking for all events based on LCM Canadian ranking from current season and LCM Canadian ranking from previous season
4. In the event of a tie, we will take their second-best event and so on until the tie is broken.

SNM will notify Post-Secondary Returning Student Swimmer Scholarship recipients by June 15, 2021. At the time of offer, scholarship recipients will be required to sign a Letter of Intent indicating their commitment to continue swimming and attending a Manitoba College or University through the remainder of the Academic Year and Swim Season of 2021-2022.

In the event there are fewer than two eligible returning swimmers, SNM reserves the right to offer additional Entrance Scholarships, to a maximum of two, to the next highest scoring swimmer(s).

Disbursement of Scholarship Funds - Scholarship funds are released in two parts.

To receive September 2021 payment, recipients must:

- a) Provide transcript from previous year
- b) Maintain full time student status
- c) Maintain a GPA of 2.5 in previous year
- d) Maintain full-time training and competition schedule as available and outlined by club for the 2021 – 2022 Swim Season

To receive the January 2022 payment, recipients must:

- a) Provide transcript from 1st term
- b) Maintain full time student status
- c) Maintain a GPA of 2.5 in 1st term
- d) Maintain full-time training and competition schedule as available and outlined by club for the 2021 – 2022 Swim Season

Recipients who withdraw from school, or retire from swimming, will not receive the second scholarship payment
